Dear Families

We are looking forward to welcoming your child to our school next year. To assist us with forward planning, we're asking you to start the enrolment process now.

There are a few steps to this:

- An Enrolment Form is enclosed together with the Student Health Care Summary Form. Please fill these out as best you can. If you require assistance, please call the school on 6866 1750.
- You'll need to provide your child's birth certificate and Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) immunisation history statement. This statement needs to be no more than two months old and is accessible via the myGov website through Medicare.
- Please bring the above documentation to the school's Manager of Corporate Services, Monday to Thursday.
- If your child needs to travel on the school bus next year, you'll need to visit School Bus Services (SBS) at <https://schoolbuses.wa.gov.au/> to apply for a seat. It is best to do this as soon as possible, to ensure they can get the routes completed in a timely manner. We have included a brochure for more information on this.
- If you would like to familiarise yourself further with the school, and the programs we offer and how we can support your child and their specific needs, do not hesitate to book a school tour and meeting with myself prior to completing the enrolment forms. For Term 2, I am currently teaching in the Junior room Monday, Wednesday morning and Friday, which restricts my availability to Tuesday and Thursday.

To ensure all students transition into their first year of school smoothly, Nyabing Primary School offers various opportunities for students to familiarise themselves with the school and their peers. We have incorporated an informal transition into our Play Café sessions in Terms 1, 2 and 3. During Term 4, we are planning on extending our current transition of four sessions. Parents will be advised once these details are confirmed.
